Hi there, a short one this time just to update you on forthcoming events and arrangements

Enrolment Fee

We have had to introduce a small annual fee of £15 per child (this is in line with all local clubs operating in the area). This fee is payable upon enrolment for the next season. Enrolment fees and forms are due back on 30th June 2005

As a result of introducing the annual enrolment fee we will be reducing the weekly match subs to £3 and this has been operating since the start of the Prostar Summer League. Children are only charged when they play in a match. Training is free of charge. Children will need to enroll to receive training.

Shirts back for badges

We are intending to sew Hurst Romans Crests on all the players' shirts during the Winter break. Can you please get your club shirt back to your manager by 15th July 2005 at the latest. The shirts need to be sent away for stitching and back with us in time for the new season kick off early September 2005. For those players playing in the Woodley Wanderers Tournament July 9/10th please remember to leave your shirt with your Manager.

Lost Fleeces / Kit

There have been a number of instances where fleeces and or other items of kit have gone missing either at matches or during training sessions. It is not the responsibility of Managers to look after kit, although we will do as much as we can to help. Controlling 8 - 10 boys (more during training) whilst at the same time collecting match subs and coaching from the sidelines makes it impossible for the manager's to be responsible for individual kit. It is also the responsibility of all players and players parents to check the name tags within the kit to make sure you have not picked someone else's!!

New Managers

We really do need more parents or friends of parents stepping forward and volunteering to help manage a team. We are in a situation where due to parent's wishes for their children to play more regular match football as well as free training, we have entered a second Under 8 team (currently Under 7 in Prostar Summer League) into the Hicks League starting in September 2005. In the short term we need a volunteer to help manage the administration and organisation on match days. The current Managers can guide & help during training sessions. If we can't find extra help we will have to pull this team from the Hicks League come September 2005. There is also a need for managers through some of the other age groups. E.g. we are getting very close to having enough children for two Under 6 teams & therefore needing a second manager (will be Under 7 this Sept in Hicks League). Please get behind us on this!
